At every book sale the Friends try to offer something new or different. This sale we will highlight "aviation." We have dedicated several shelves for that subject and by the time of our sale will have over one hundred volumes on flight both in times of war and peace. To avoid congestion in the area where we traditionally locate books on military history (our militaria section is also full), we have placed the aviation section on the opposite side of the sales room. In addition, we have a new horror section and have lots of children's books for this sale. Anyone who is interested in these subjects needs to be at our upcoming, November book sale.

Your Friends directors continue to meet and discuss the appropriate steps relative to the upcoming capital campaign to renovate the Library complex. The Friends must move from the basement of the main library in order to create space for the expansion of library services; that means that a new building must be constructed on the grounds of the library complex. Your directors are currently contemplating how best to proceed to assist in building a new Friends structure for our book room. As president, it is my responsibility to push aggressively on this concept. However, it is also my responsibility to be financially prudent at the same time. We can not spend Friends investments too

aggressively without curtailing investment income needed to continue those library programs which we now fund, such as the summer reading program for our youth and purchases of large print books for our older citizens. So the directors walk a fine line of responsibility on this issue. Before this edition of *Il Folio* goes to print, the directors will have a meeting with one member of the city council to informally discuss what the city might be willing to do to assist the Friends in constructing a new sales room.

Regardless of what the Friends directors will ultimately decide to do about a possible, new sales facility, this writer has decided to step down as president at the end of the current year in order to devote more time to the library capital campaign. So do not be surprised to hear from me in 2010 and 2011 about possibly donating to the library capital campaign. So the Friends in 2010 will have several new officers, including a new president and new editor of the *Il Folio*. I will remain on the board as the immediate past president. It has been my privilege to serve as president for the last five years and editor of the *Il Folio* for approximately eight plus years.
