Household Hazardous Waste Collection

For Kerr County Residents (Both City & County)

It's that time again for the spring and fall household hazardous "drop off" event presented by the Solid Waste Division. The event is scheduled for Saturday, May 1, 2010 and Saturday, November 13, 2010 at the Community Recycling Center in Kerrville. All Kerr county residents are eligible to participate in this worthwhile event. **The hours of operation will be from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm that day. The Community Recycling Center will close early on Friday, April 30, 2010 and Friday, November 12, 2010 at 3:00 pm in preparation for this collection. Residents only; no commercial businesses please!**

Acceptable item (s):

Bring material in original containers, five gallon maximum size

We ask that our citizens please adhere to no more than 30 gallons per vehicle total.

- Automotive: **Passenger Tires only** (with or without rims) Limit 12
- Automotive: Batteries, cleaners and antifreeze,
- Gardening: Pesticides, Insecticides, Fungicides, and Herbicides
- Cleaning: Drain, Oven & Household Cleaners, and Pool Chemicals
- Paint Products: Latex or Oil, Stains, Thinners, and Removers
- Tanks: Propane tanks < 50 lbs capacity (with a removable valve)
- Mercury: Thermometers, thermostats and any other small devices
- Fluorescent light bulbs

Please remember that some of the local automotive businesses accept used motor oil at no expense during their business hours.

Prohibited material at this event:

Ammunition, Explosives, Biohazards, Radioactive Material, and Gas Cylinders.

Guidelines for bringing items:

- Bring products in their original containers
- Do not mix or consolidate products
- Properly seal containers to prevent leaking
- Place materials in areas away from driver and or passengers
- Collection site personnel have the right to refuse material not considered appropriate for this event

Tire Amnesty Day!

As a one-time occurrence, at this collection we will accept only up to 12 (twelve) passenger highway road tires (with or without rims) brought in by residents of Kerr County. **Residents only; no commercial businesses please!**
