Main Street Meeting Procedures during the Disaster Declaration

COVID-19 (Coronavirus) provides a unique concern in that gathering members of the public and City staff within a physical setting constitutes a public health risk. On March 16, 2020, the Texas Governor suspended certain requirements of the Open Meetings Act to permit open meetings to occur in a fully virtual setting (e.g., telephonic or videoconference meeting).

In an effort to avoid and mitigate health risks, and limited occupancy levels in Council Chambers, the Main Street Advisory Board will convene in a virtual forum and attendance will be limited to only those persons essential to holding the meeting. No member of the public will be admitted into Council Chambers during this time.

Citizens can provide public comment on specific agenda items through Zoom. Zoom toll free number is 1-800-832-5611, or alternate telephone numbers are 346 248 7799 or 252 215 8132. The Meeting ID is **967 9616 1266#**. (You must enter the pound sign (#) after the Meeting ID). Speakers must call in by 2:45 p.m., September 16, 2020 and register with the Zoom moderator, and each speaker is limited to four minutes.

A person may also submit written comments on specific agenda items to include public hearings, and comments will be read into the meeting record. Comments must include a name, address, and a reference to the relevant item. Comments that do not include such information will not be read. Comments must be received by 2:45 p.m., September 16, 2020. Comments may be:
