Mary Ellen Summerlin officially files as candidate for the Place 1 Councilmember on the Kerrville City Council

Kerrville (February 3, 2021) – On Feb. 3, 2021, City Secretary Shelley McElhannon announced that Mary Ellen Summerlin has officially filed as a candidate for the Office of Councilmember Place 1 on the Kerrville City Council. Summerlin's application has been verified for eligibility and found to be sufficient; therefore, Mary Ellen Summerlin is an official candidate for the Office of Place 1 on the Kerrville City Council at the May 1, 2021 municipal election.

In accordance with the City Charter, any person who lawfully qualifies and is a registered voter of the City of Kerrville may file an application for a place on the ballot. Councilmembers are elected at large and serve two-year terms. Qualifications as stated in the Texas Election Code and the Kerrville City Charter are listed on the city's website: www.kerrvilletx.gov.
