### **Summer Adult Co-Ed Soccer League accepting registration**

**Kerrville, Texas (May 6, 2021)** – Get your cleats and shin guards out because it is that time of the year! The Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department is currently accepting registration for our Adult Co-Ed Summer Soccer League. The team entry fee is \$350 and is due by May 28. Late registration will be accepted till June 4, and a \$50 fee will be assessed. A minimum of six teams is needed to begin the league. The season will begin June 8 and will follow a standard league format. Format will be 8v8 play with the top four teams advancing to the playoffs at the end of the season. Games will be played at the Kerrville Soccer Complex located at 117 Sweeper Lane. Games will be held every Tuesday and Thursday.

A mandatory captain's meeting will be held Friday, June 4 at 5:30 p.m. at the recreation hall located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park (2385 Bandera Hwy.). Teams must have representation at the meeting, with a maximum of two reps per team. Those that are interested in playing but do not have a team can contact the Parks and Recreation Department to be considered for pick up by one of the established teams; however, this is not a guarantee.
