### **Haunted Ghoul Pool to be held at Olympic Pool**

**Kerrville, Texas (October 8, 2021)** – The Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to announce that the *Haunted Ghoul Pool* event will be back this fall! Join us for a night of goosebumps, spooks, and screams as the Olympic Pool, 601 Olympic Dr., will be transformed into a ghoulish haunted house. The *Haunted Ghoul Pool* will be held Saturday and Sunday, Oct. 23-24, starting at 5 p.m. Both a family-friendly tour and a terrifying tour will take place.

Family-friendly tours will run from 5-6:30 p.m. both nights. From 7-8:30 p.m. both nights, parental guidance is suggested for anyone under the age of 13 as the haunted attractions will come to life and the scary factor will be turned up. Please take note of these times so that you are attending at the appropriate time for your desired choice of haunt.

The entrance fee will be \$5 per person for ages four and up. Tickets are on sale now. You can purchase them online, over the phone at (830) 257-7300, and at the Parks and Recreation Department located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, 2385 Bandera Hwy. Tickets can also be purchased on-site at the event. Note that the ticket is valid for only one night.

The haunt will use fog, intense sounds and strobe lights. Enter at your own risk. Rules are as follows: no running or smoking, no touching props or actors, no video or photography will be allowed inside the haunt, and all direction by staff must be adhered to. Please note that swimming will not be allowed. Cash or check only for ticket purchases at the pool; refunds will not be given.
