Brenda Hughes officially files as candidate for the Place 4 Councilmember on the Kerrville City Council

Kerrville (Jan. 24, 2022) – On Jan. 24, 2022, City Secretary Shelley McElhannon announced that Brenda Hughes has officially filed as a candidate for the Office of Councilmember Place 4 on the Kerrville City Council. Hughes' application has been verified for eligibility and found to be sufficient; therefore, Brenda Hughes is an official candidate for the Office of Place 4 on the Kerrville City Council at the May 7, 2022 municipal election.

In accordance with the City Charter, any person who lawfully qualifies and is a registered voter of the City of Kerrville may file an application for a place on the ballot.



Councilmembers are elected at large and serve two year terms; qualifications as stated in the Texas Election Code and the Kerrville City Charter are listed on the City's website:
