City's wastewater division to smoke test Kerr South sewer system


Kerrville, Texas (Oct. 10, 2022) – The City of Kerrville's wastewater collections division will be performing smoke testing on the sewer system in the Kerr South area Wednesday and Thursday, Oct. 12 and 13, from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m. each day.

Smoke Testing will help identify if there is water infiltration and/or breaks in the sewer collection system. The reduction of infiltration helps reduce overall operations costs and reduces the number of blockages.

The streets to be smoke tested include Trace, Rancho Oaks, Lydick, Quail Valley, Loyal Valley, and Frederick.

No incendiary devices are used to produce smoke. The liquid smoke that is being used is non-toxic and will dissipate quickly.

The city thanks our citizens in advance for their patience and cooperation during the testing.
