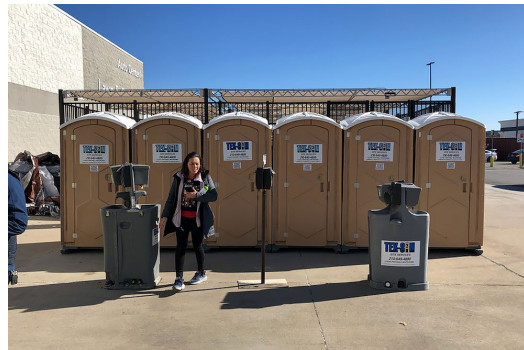

Walmart working to restore water following water pipe break

Kerrville, Texas (Dec. 24, 2022) – On Dec. 23, 2022, Walmart experienced a water pipe break that impacted store operations. Walmart, in coordination with the City of Kerrville, shut down all food preparation and food services. Walmart arranged with other businesses to allow their staff to use the facilities temporarily.

As of Saturday, Dec. 24, 2022, The City of Kerrville has verified the following with Walmart:



- Walmart is working with a plumber to restore services. Due to parts not being available, alternative methods will be implemented to establish temporary water services.
- All food preparation and food services will continue to be closed.
- Walmart has contracted with Tex-San to provide portable restroom service that include hand washing stations. These services are available to all employees and the public.

Walmart and the City of Kerrville's Development Services and Fire Department are working closely to ensure the water services are restored as quickly as possible.
