Weather conditions to improve today

Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 2, 2023) – Per the National Weather Service, a Winter Storm Warning remains in effect locally through 10 a.m. this morning, with weather conditions improving through the rest of the day.

PER THE KERRVILLE STREET DEPARTMENT:

• All bridges (including TXDOT owned) inside the city limits were treated with magnesium chloride and gravel last night. A heavy rain around 1 a.m. seemed to thaw some



areas and currently treatment operations are suspended and the street division remains in standby mode.

- All streets and bridges are passable at this time.
- Temperatures remained steady at or just below freezing with random spells of rain and a light wind. Sampled road surfaces are reading in the lower 30's.

- Road surfaces are wet with no reports of ice.
- No power outages have been observed.
- Most elevated surfaces, vehicles, sidewalks and driveways have a thin film of ice with little accumulation on trees.
