Carver Park sprayground will open March 1 for 2023 season

Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 28, 2023) – The Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to announce that the Carver Park sprayground will open for the 2023 season on March 1 at 10 a.m. The sprayground is free of charge and will be open from March – October, from 10 a.m. to dark, and will be closed every Tuesday for routine maintenance. Carver Park is located at 820 Webster Ave. and features a covered playground, large and small pavilion with grills, multiuse field, covered picnic tables close to the sprayground, and a walking trail.

Spraygrounds, also called water playgrounds or splash pads, are essentially playgrounds with the water component incorporated into features for added fun. Commonly, spraygrounds such as the one at Carver Park are controlled by hand-activated motion sensors to run for a designated amount of time, with treated water that has high level of quality similar to swimming pool water standards.

Rules for the sprayground include:

- Non-service animals are prohibited.

- Changing diapers within six feet of the water feature is prohibited.
- You may not use water feature if ill with contagious disease or diarrhea.
- Do not drink water from the water feature.
- Not to be used during bad weather.
- No running.
