Spend Spring Break at Kerrville-Schreiner Park

Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 27, 2023) – Spring Break is only a few weeks away and Kerrville-Schreiner Park is the perfect place to start your adventure. The 517-acre park is located at 2385 Bandera Hwy., resting along the beautiful Guadalupe River. Kerrville-Schreiner Park is an overnight campground offering RV sites, tent camping, mini cabins, park cabin, group rental facilities, a tepee, and a ranch house. Spots are filling up fast! Book your overnight reservation now.



Whether you visit for the day or stay overnight, you can spend your time at Kerrville-Schreiner Park exploring more than 13 miles of hiking and biking trails in addition to six miles of paved River Trail. Enjoy swimming, fishing, and paddling on the Guadalupe.

Day use admission fees are \$6 for ages 13 years+, \$2 for children and seniors (65 years+), and are free for veterans and active duty military (proof of service required). If you want to gain

year-round access to the park, now is a great time to buy an annual pass at only \$50 per year.

Purchase an annual pass between March 13-17 and receive a free Kerrville-Schreiner Park giveaway, while supplies last.

There will be snacks for families to enjoy while supplies last, as well as board games and activities for everyone! Unplug from devices and spend quality time with your family and friends while playing games.
- **Movies in the Park** – On Saturday, March 18, the “Movies in the Park” series is back at the Kerrville-Schreiner Park amphitheater. The movie will begin at dark. Bring the family, chairs,

blankets, insect repellant and a flashlight for an outdoor evening of fun. Free popcorn will be served and drinks will be available for purchase.
