Library to host author David M. Hillis Wednesday

Kerrville, Texas (June 12, 2023) – The Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library welcomes Hill Country author David M. Hillis this Wednesday, June 14, to discuss his recently published book, “Armadillos to Ziziphus: A Naturalist in the Texas Hill Country.” Hillis will cover reasons for the high biodiversity of the Hill Country, what we have lost, and some ways we can support preservation and restoration of the area’s natural resources.



Hillis, director of the Biodiversity Center, is the Alfred Roark Centennial Professor of Natural Sciences at the University of Texas at Austin, where he studies the evolution and biodiversity of life.

Wednesday’s program starts at 1 p.m. in the library’s first floor meeting room. A book signing and sale will be held at the end of the event. Light refreshments will be served.
