2. CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION:

2.A. Approval of minutes for the Senior Services Advisory Committee meeting held August 25, 2022.

2.B. Boomer's & Beyond Senior Prom Event – Update - POSTPONED – Waverly Jones

Boomer's would like to partner with SSAC for our Valentine's Dance on February 11, 2023 from 2pm – 4pm at the Dietert Center. Waverly has secured a DJ and photo booth. Dietert Center will provide decorations. Clifton Fifer will do line dance lessons. Kim Melsmer will apply for H-E-B Community Investment Grant for other food and drinks. Ask Boomer's to be in charge of food. City will take care of flyer and advertising i.e. press release and Facebook post with reminders. Be sure to stress that it is NOT a couples only dance – singles are welcome to come have a good time. Ask a youth dance organization like CeCe's to perform. Provide "thank you" valentine with sucker to performers or helpers. Motion by Waverly Jones to approve, Karen Burkett seconded, and the motion passed.

Next meeting to be held on Thursday, October 27, 2022.


