### **Veterans advocate to host suicide prevention program Saturday at library**

**Kerrville, Texas (Jan. 17, 2024)** – In an effort to reduce suicides in the Hill Country, Together With Hill Country Veterans is hosting a suicide prevention program Saturday, Jan. 20 at 2 p.m. in the Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library's meeting room.

Led by Kathy Turner, a seasoned clinical social worker with decades of experience, this program aims



to provide attendees with essential insights and skills to address the challenging issue of suicide. Have you ever suspected that someone you cared about was struggling with thoughts of suicide, but you didn't know what to say or do? This program is designed to help you learn how to identify signs, what to listen and look for, and most importantly, how to respond appropriately and refer individuals to professional help.
