City of Kerrville announces Kerrville Eclipse Festival event parking and Kerrville Sports Complex viewing location

Kerrville, Texas (Feb. 27, 2024) – On April 8, 2024 the City of Kerrville will welcome guests visiting Kerrville to witness the total solar eclipse. In anticipation of these guests, the City of Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department is hosting an event, the [Kerrville Eclipse Festival](#), and will organize separate eclipse viewing locations at [Kerrville Sports Complex](#). Parking information for the event and separate viewing locations are listed here.

Kerrville Eclipse Festival

Off-site paid event parking for the Kerrville Eclipse Festival will be available at Tivy High School, 3250 TX-534 Loop, for \$60 per vehicle. Registration for off-site event parking opens today, Feb 27, at 8:30 a.m. CST. Those wishing to reserve an event parking spot can do so by visiting www.kerrvilletx.gov/eclipsefestival. At-the-gate sales will NOT occur on the day of the event. On March 11 at 8:30 a.m. CST, the cost of parking will increase to \$100 per vehicle, so you are encouraged to secure your spot as soon as possible.

A shuttle will take attendees from Tivy High School to the Kerrville Eclipse Festival in Louise Hays Park. Parking at Tivy High School is exclusively for those wishing to attend the festival. Staying at Tivy High School to view the eclipse is prohibited. All guests must park and immediately board the next available shuttle. Shuttles will begin transporting event attendees at 8:00 a.m. to allow time for all guests to arrive at the festival before totality. The parking lot will open at 7:30 a.m. and it is recommended to arrive early to allow enough time for the shuttles to transport everyone to the event. The shuttles will cease operations from 1 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.

Limited, free parking will be available on a first-come-first-serve basis in the Parking Garage at 201 Clay St. in Downtown Kerrville. The Parking Garage is open 24/7. Overnight camping inside the parking garage is strictly prohibited. The parking lot at the Butt Holdsworth Memorial Library, 505 Water St., will have limited free first-come-first-serve accessible parking spots available to the public. You must have a state-issued person with disabilities plate or placard to park in an accessible parking space. Parking along the road is not allowed.

Kerrville Sports Complex Eclipse Viewing Location

Parking spaces to view the eclipse at the Kerrville Sports Complex are still available. Located conveniently near I-10, this is a great option for guests who want to ensure they have a secure place to go and do not want to attend the Kerrville Eclipse Festival. Your reservation at the Sports Complex will guarantee you a parking space and grant you access to grassy sports fields with plenty of space for all to enjoy the eclipse. Restrooms, water access, and a limited food vendor will be available on both sides of the Kerrville Sports Complex. Parking

passes are for sale for \$75 per vehicle until March 11 at 8:30 a.m. CST when prices will increase to \$100 per vehicle. Gates to the Sports Complex will open at 8:00 a.m. A shuttle to the Kerrville Eclipse Festival will not be provided.
