Butler, Fifer to talk Hill Country baseball Saturday at History Center

Kerrville, Texas (June 18, 2024) – The Kerr Regional History Center is pleased to announce that on Saturday, June 22 at 2 p.m., noted baseball historian Dick Butler and famed local storyteller and historical interpreter Clifton Fifer will speak on the topic of “Baseball in the Hill Country” during the depression era and beyond.

Butler is a lifelong baseball fan and a retired attorney. After moving to the Texas Hill



Country in 2022, Butler became fascinated with the history of baseball in the region. A member of the Society of American Baseball Research (SABR) since 1983, Butler employed his analytical skills and baseball knowledge to research the story of Hill Country baseball.

Fifer is a retired Kerrville school teacher and fourth-generation Texan who brings history to life via storytelling, poetry, music and dance. With baseball, Fifer brings the first-hand knowledge of his father's and others' time with The Kerrville All Stars.

The public is encouraged to attend and enjoy learning about the important role baseball teams played for the community. The event is free of charge.
