Kerrville, Texas (June 11, 2024) – Kerrville-Schreiner Park (KSP) may be the city's number one hidden gem. Tucked away on the Guadalupe River, KSP is 517 acres of Hill Country wilderness, just three miles from charming and historic Downtown Kerrville. The park offers overnight camping and cabin rentals, more than 13 miles of hiking and mountain biking trails, and a spacious, shady riverfront perfect for picnicking and paddling.

June is National Get Outdoors Month and National Camping Month, so it is the perfect time to sleep under the stars of the Hill Country night sky. The rentable riverside tent sites, full hook-up RV sites, tepee and cabins make it the perfect camping spot for vacationers or those looking for a fun staycation. To celebrate Father's Day this Sunday, June 16, all fathers and father figures can get into Kerrville-Schreiner Park for free with the purchase of a child day pass. Be sure to stop by and see what Kerrville-Schreiner Park has to offer.

Kerrville-Schreiner Park was built by the historic Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930s and was a state park until 2004 when the City of Kerrville adopted it as a city park. As one of

the best mountain biking destinations in the Hill Country, this location is highly sought after by adventure seekers and outdoor enthusiasts alike. Day passes and annual passes are also available, so make sure to put Kerrville-Schreiner Park at the top of your summer list.
