About Kerrville-Schreiner Park

Tucked away on the Guadalupe River, Kerrville-Schreiner Park offers overnight camping and cabin rentals, more than 13 miles of hiking and mountain biking trails, and a spacious, shady riverfront perfect for picnicking and paddling.

Kerrville-Schreiner Park was built by the historic Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930s and was a state park until 2004, when the City of Kerrville adopted it as a city park. As one of the best mountain biking destinations in the Hill Country, this location is highly sought after by adventure seekers, RVers, and outdoor enthusiasts alike.
