Groundbreaking ceremony for A.C. Schreiner House renovation Tuesday

Kerrville, Texas (Nov. 8, 2024) – The City of Kerrville invites all citizens to a groundbreaking ceremony Tuesday, Nov. 12 at 2:30 p.m. at 529 Water Street as we kick off renovations for the A.C. Schreiner House. Mayor Joe Herring, Jr. and Angela Kennedy, executive director for the Heart of the Hills Heritage Center, will be guest speakers, with the groundbreaking and refreshments to follow.

The Schreiner House is set to be the home of the new Heart of the Hills Heritage Center, which is expected to open in 2026. Renovations are being undertaken through a public-private partnership between the city and the Heart of the Hills Heritage Foundation. Public funding for the renovation amounts to \$6 million.
