

**CITY OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS
RESOLUTION NO. 38-2025**

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THAT A GENERAL ELECTION BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2026 FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR MAYOR, PLACE 3, AND PLACE 4; PROVIDING DETAILS RELATING TO THE HOLDING OF SUCH ELECTION; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE KERRVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE HOLDING OF A JOINT ELECTION BETWEEN THE TWO ENTITIES; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT

WHEREAS, Section 2.03 of the City Charter establishes a two-year term of office for each City Councilmember, until a successor is elected; and

WHEREAS, the terms of office for the Mayor and Councilmembers Place Three and Place Four will expire in May 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code (the "Code"), Section 41.001, specifies that Saturday, May 2, 2026, will serve as the general election date for the State of Texas and that a general election of a city may be held on such date; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds it in the public interest to call a general election to be held on Saturday, May 2, 2026 for the election of persons to the offices of Mayor and Councilmember Place Three and Councilmember Place Four (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, City Council is ordering the Election for the City of Kerrville, Texas, not later than 78 days before the election day pursuant to Section 3.005(c) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, City Council, pursuant to the Code, will contract with the Kerr County Elections Officer, who is the Kerr County Clerk (the "Elections Officer"), to conduct all aspects of the Election; and

WHEREAS, the Kerrville Independent School District ("KISD") may also hold an election on May 2, 2026, and like the City, is entering into an agreement with the Elections Officer for services related to holding the election; and

WHEREAS, City Council, pursuant to Chapter 271 of the Code, will contract with KISD to jointly hold the Election under the authority of this law; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds and determines that the actions described above are in the best interests of the residents and voters of the City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, KERR COUNTY, TEXAS:**

SECTION ONE. The facts and matters contained in the preamble above are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION TWO. City Council orders that a general election be held for the City of Kerrville, Texas, on Saturday, May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing the following officials of the City:

**Mayor
Councilmember, Place Three
Councilmember, Place Four**

SECTION THREE. City Council approves the *Interlocal Agreement for a Joint Election between the City and KISD* (the "Agreement") and authorizes the Mayor to sign same, such Agreement as authorized by Chapter 271 of the Code. The Agreement is attached as **Exhibit A**, and authorizes the City and KISD to conduct a joint election, should both entities hold elections.

SECTION FOUR. Qualified persons may file for a place on the ballot by filing an application in the Office of the City Secretary during regular business hours from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM each weekday beginning Wednesday, January 14, 2026 and continuing until 5:00 PM on Friday, February 13, 2026.

SECTION FIVE. The present boundaries of the City, constituting one election precinct, the polls shall be open for voting on **Election Day, Saturday May 2, 2026, from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM** at the following polling place:

SECTION SIX. All resident qualified electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at said election. This election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the Code; the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and the Agreement; the City Charter; and as may be required by law. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish. Kerr County will utilize its voting equipment for this election.

SECTION SEVEN. The Elections Officer is appointed as Early Voting Clerk and the City Secretary shall serve as the Deputy Early Voting Clerk. Applications for

ballot by mail must be received by mail no later than the close of business on Monday, April 21, 2026, at the following Mailing Address: Elections Officer, Attn: Early Voting Clerk, Kerr County Courthouse, 700 Main Street, Kerrville, Texas, 78028.

SECTION EIGHT. The Elections Officer shall appoint the Election Judge and officers for the polling place and the Early Voting Ballot Board in accordance with the provisions of the Code and the Agreement. The City authorizes the Elections Officer to make changes, substitutions, or additions as to any voting official in accordance with the Code and the Agreement.

SECTION NINE. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted by Elections Officer in accordance with the Agreement. In accordance with the Code, the Elections Officer may appoint one or more deputy early voting clerks. Early voting shall be conducted at the Union Church Building, 101 Travis St., Kerrville, Texas, 78028, April 20, 2026 through April 28, 2026, and in accordance with the Code, as follows:

- ~~Tuesday~~ ^{MONDAY}, April 20, 2026, through Friday, April 24, 2026: 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM
- Monday, April 27, 2026, and Tuesday, April 28, 2026: 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM

SECTION TEN. City Council will conduct the official canvass of the election at a special meeting on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at the Arcadia Theater, 717 Water Street, Kerrville, Texas, where official notice of this election shall comply with state law, to include the Open Meetings Act.

SECTION ELEVEN. City Council gives the City Secretary the authority to take any action(s) to ensure that the election is conducted in accordance with the Code and the Agreement, to include alternating the dates, places, or actions described above. Should the City Secretary be required to take action, which alters any of the information or actions described above, she shall provide written notice of the action to Council as soon as possible.

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EXHIBIT A

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR A JOINT ELECTION BETWEEN THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, TEXAS AND KERRVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

This Interlocal Agreement for a Joint Election (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between the City of Kerrville ("City"), a municipal corporation situated in Kerr County, Texas, and Kerrville Independent School District ("KISD"), a Texas Independent School District situated in Kerr County, Texas, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791, Texas Government Code; and Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code. The City and KISD may be referred to as "Party" or collectively as "Parties".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City and KISD will each hold elections on Saturday, May 2, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code authorizes two or more political subdivisions holding elections on the same day in all or part of the same county to enter into an agreement to hold their elections jointly in the election precincts that can be served by common polling places; and

WHEREAS, the City and KISD believe it to be in the public interest to enter into this Agreement, which authorizes the parties, in conjunction with the Kerr County Clerk, to hold a joint election pursuant to Chapter 271, Texas Election Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I - PURPOSE. The purpose of this Agreement is to authorize the City and KISD to hold a joint election on May 2, 2026, pursuant to Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code, and to share those common polling places that serve the voters of both jurisdictions. The Parties have each entered into separate agreements with the Kerr County Clerk who has agreed to conduct the elections. Each Party will continue to work with the Kerr County Clerk and each other to conduct their elections as productively and efficiently as possible. This Agreement shall also apply to any runoff election.

ARTICLE II - TERM. The term of this Agreement is to commence upon final execution of this Agreement by the Parties and shall end upon the final canvassing conducted by each Party pursuant to its election.

ARTICLE III - LOCATION OF COMMON POLLING PLACES. The voters of particular election precincts may be served in this joint election by a common polling place located outside the boundary of the election precinct, inasmuch as the parties hereto have determined that the locations of such polling places, as recommended by the Kerr County Clerk, will adequately and conveniently serve the affected voters and will facilitate the orderly

conduct of the elections, pursuant to Section 271.003 of the Texas Election Code.

ARTICLE IV - ALLOCATION OF EXPENSES. City and KISD shall provide to the Kerr County Clerk, from current revenues available to the paying party, their respective share of costs, as determined by the Kerr County Clerk, pursuant to Section 271.004 of the Texas Election Code. If a Party cancels an election, then its share of the costs shall be adjusted accordingly.

ARTICLE V - EARLY VOTING. The parties hereto agree to conduct early voting jointly, pursuant to Section 271.006 of the Texas Election Code.

ARTICLE VI - AMENDMENTS. This Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties hereto in writing to be attached to and incorporated into this Agreement.

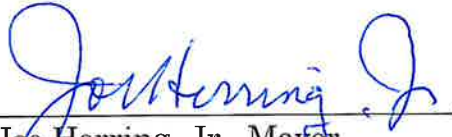
ARTICLE VII - LEGAL CONSTRUCTIONS. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

ARTICLE VIII- ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement supersedes any and all other agreements, either oral or in writing, between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and no other agreement, statement, or promise relating to the subject matter of this Agreement which is not contained herein shall be valid or binding.

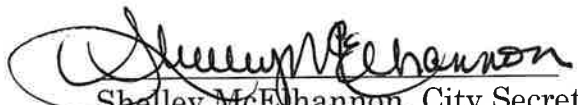

UNA RESOLUCIÓN QUE ORDENA QUE SE CELEBREN ELECCIONES GENERALES EL SÁBADO 2 DE MAYO DE 2026 PARA LA ELECCIÓN DE TRES CONCEJALES PARA ALCALDE, LUGAR 3 Y LUGAR 4; PROPORCIONANDO DETALLES RELACIONADOS CON LA CELEBRACIÓN DE DICHAS ELECCIONES; AUTORIZAR AL ALCALDE A CELEBRAR UN ACUERDO CON EL DISTRITO ESCOLAR INDEPENDIENTE DE KERRVILLE PARA LA CELEBRACIÓN DE UNA ELECCIÓN CONJUNTA ENTRE AMBAS ENTIDADES; Y PROPORCIONANDO OTROS ASUNTOS RELACIONADOS CON EL TEMA

CONSIDERANDO QUE, la Sección 2.03 de la Carta de la Ciudad establece un mandato de dos años para cada miembro del Ayuntamiento, hasta que se elija un sucesor; y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, los mandatos del alcalde y los concejales Puesto Tres y Puesto Cuatro expirarán en mayo de 2026; y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, el Código Electoral de Texas (el "Código"), Sección 41.001, especifica que el sábado 2 de mayo de 2026 servirá como fecha de las elecciones generales para el Estado de Texas y que una elección general de una ciudad podrá celebrarse en dicha fecha; y

MIENTRAS QUE, el Ayuntamiento considera de interés público convocar elecciones generales que se celebrarán el sábado 2 de mayo de 2026 para la elección de personas para los cargos de alcalde y concejal Lugar Tres y Lugar Cuatro de Concejal (la "Elección"); y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, el Ayuntamiento ordena la elección para la ciudad de Kerrville, Texas, a más tardar 78 días antes del día de la elección conforme a la Sección 3.005(c) del Código; y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, de acuerdo con el Ayuntamiento, conforme al Código, contratará al Oficial de Elecciones del Condado de Kerr, que es el Secretario del Condado de Kerr (el "Oficial de Elecciones"), para llevar a cabo todos los aspectos de la Elección; y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, el Distrito Escolar Independiente de Kerrville ("KISD") también puede celebrar elecciones el 2 de mayo de 2026 y, al igual que la ciudad, está celebrando un acuerdo con el Oficial de Elecciones para servicios relacionados con la celebración de la elección; y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, de acuerdo con el Capítulo 271 del Código, el Ayuntamiento contratará con el KISD para celebrar conjuntamente las elecciones bajo la autoridad de esta ley; y

CONSIDERANDO QUE, el Ayuntamiento considera y determina que las acciones descritas anteriormente son en el mejor interés de los residentes y votantes de la ciudad;

POR TANTO, QUE EL AYUNTAMIENTO DE LA CIUDAD DE KERRVILLE, CONDADO DE KERR, TEXAS, RESUELVA:

SECCIÓN UNO. Los hechos y asuntos contenidos en el preámbulo anterior se consideran verdaderos y correctos, se incorporan en este documento y se incorporan a todo lo que pueden.

SECCIÓN DOS. El Ayuntamiento ordena que se celebren elecciones generales para la ciudad de Kerrville, Texas, el sábado 2 de mayo de 2026, con el fin de elegir a los siguientes funcionarios de la ciudad:

**Alcalde
Concejal, Lugar Tres
Concejal, Lugar Cuatro**

SECCIÓN TRES. El Ayuntamiento aprueba el *Acuerdo Interlocal para una Elección Conjunta entre la Ciudad y el KISD* (el "Acuerdo") y autoriza al alcalde a firmarlo, dicho Acuerdo autorizado por el Capítulo 271 del Código. El Acuerdo se adjunta como **Anexo A** y autoriza a la Ciudad y al KISD a celebrar elecciones conjuntas, en caso de que ambas entidades celebren elecciones.

SECCIÓN CUATRO. Las personas cualificadas pueden solicitar un puesto en la papeleta presentando una solicitud en la Oficina del Secretario de la Ciudad durante el horario laboral habitual, de 8:00 a 17:00 de lunes a viernes, a partir del miércoles 14 de enero de 2026 y continuando hasta las 17:00 horas del viernes 13 de febrero de 2026.

SECCIÓN CINCO. Los límites actuales de la ciudad, que constituyen un solo distrito electoral, y los colegios electorales estarán abiertos para votación el **día de las elecciones, sábado 2 de mayo de 2026, de 7:00 a 19:00** en el siguiente colegio electoral:

SECCIÓN SIX. Todos los electores residentes calificados de la ciudad podrán votar en dicha elección. Esta elección se celebrará y se llevará a cabo conforme al Código; la Ley Federal de Derechos de Voto de 1965, enmendada, y el Acuerdo; la Carta de la Ciudad; y según lo requiera la ley. Todos los materiales y actas electorales se imprimirán tanto en inglés como en español. El condado de Kerr utilizará su equipo de votación para estas elecciones.

SECCIÓN SIETE. El Oficial de Elecciones es nombrado como Secretario de Votación Anticipada y el Secretario Municipal actuará como Secretario Adjunto de Votación Anticipada. Las solicitudes de papeleta por correo deben recibirse por correo a más tardar al cierre de la sesión del lunes 21 de abril de 2026, en la siguiente dirección postal: Oficial de Elecciones, Atento: Secretario de Votación Anticipada, Palacio de Justicia del Condado de Kerr, 700 Main Street, Kerrville, Texas, 78028.

SECCIÓN OCHO. El Oficial Electoral nombrará al Juez Electoral y a los funcionarios del colegio electoral y a la Junta de Votación Anticipada conforme a las disposiciones del Código y el Acuerdo. La Ciudad autoriza al Oficial Electoral a realizar cambios, sustituciones o añadidos en cualquier funcionario electoral conforme al Código y al Acuerdo.

SECCIÓN NUEVE. La votación anticipada por comparecencia personal será realizada por el Oficial de Elecciones conforme al Acuerdo. De acuerdo con el Código, el Oficial Electoral puede nombrar a uno o más secretarios adjuntos de votación anticipada. La votación anticipada se realizará en el Edificio de la Iglesia Unión, 101 Travis St., Kerrville, Texas, 78028, del 20 de abril de 2026 al 28 de abril de 2026, y conforme al Código, de la siguiente manera:

- Lunes, 27 de abril de 2026, y martes, 28 de abril de 2026: de 8:00 a 18:00

SECCIÓN DIEZ. El Ayuntamiento llevará a cabo la encuesta oficial de las elecciones en una reunión especial el martes 12 de mayo de 2026 en el Teatro Arcadia, 717 Water Street, Kerrville, Texas, donde el aviso oficial de esta elección cumplirá con la ley estatal, incluyendo la Ley de Reuniones Abiertas.

SECCIÓN ONCE. El Ayuntamiento otorga al Secretario Municipal la autoridad para tomar cualquier acción que garantice que la elección se lleve a cabo conforme al Código y al Acuerdo, incluyendo alternar fechas, lugares o acciones descritas anteriormente. Si la Secretaria Municipal debe tomar medidas que alteren alguna de las informaciones o acciones descritas anteriormente, deberá notificar por escrito al Ayuntamiento lo antes posible.
