**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S
SUBMISSION OF A CREATIVE FORCES
COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT GRANT TO THE
NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS;
AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PARTNER WITH
THE KERRVILLE CONVENTION AND VISITORS
BUREAU, COMMUNITY ARTS PROGRAM TO
UTILIZE FUNDS FROM THE CREATIVE FORCES
COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT GRANT; AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS
THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL
MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE PARTICIPATION
IN THE OUR TOWN PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Kerrville desires to develop a viable community, enhancing the health, well-being, and quality of life for military-connected individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Creative Forces Community Engagement Grant Program achieves this by funding arts initiatives that encourage creativity, build social connections, and improve resilience; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the importance of local partners in pursuing these goals; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds it to be in the public interest to partner with the Kerrville Convention and Visitor Bureau, Community Arts Program to apply for and utilize funding under the Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, KERR COUNTY, TEXAS:**

SECTION ONE. City Council authorizes the City's application to the Creative Forces Community Engagement Grant with the National Endowment for the Arts for funding consideration.


SECTION TWO. City Council authorizes the City to apply for \$25,000.00 of grant funds to carry out arts initiatives for military-connected individuals.

SECTION THREE. City Council authorizes the City to partner with the Kerrville Convention and Visitors Bureau, Community Arts Program to utilize the


