**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO  
SUBMIT, ON BEHALF OF THE KERRVILLE CULTURAL  
ARTS DISTRICT COMMITTEE, A GRANT APPLICATION  
WITH THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON THE ARTS, ARTS  
RESPOND PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Commission of the Arts ("TCA") funds a wide variety of funding for the arts and cultural activities across the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Kerrville is qualified to apply for grant funds pursuant to its creation and the designation of a TCA Cultural Arts District; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council finds it to be of economic development interest to apply for grant funding from the TCA that if awarded, will fund programs intended to diversify the local economy, generate revenue, and attract visitors and investment within the City's Cultural Arts District;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KERRVILLE, KERR COUNTY, TEXAS:**


**SECTION ONE.** City Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to submit an application for grant funding from the Texas Commission of the Arts and its Arts Respond Project. Such action also authorizes the City Manager or designee to act on behalf of the City in all matters related to this grant application and program not to exceed a grant match of \$40,000.00.

**SECTION TWO.** If awarded the grant, the City Manager will comply with the grant requirements of TCA to include that the City will use the grant funds and any grant-funded equipment only for those purposes specified under the grant.
