***Meeting Procedures during the Disaster Declaration
and Citizen/Public Participation Guidelines***

COVID-19 (Coronavirus) provides a unique concern in that gathering members of the public, Committee members, and City staff within a physical setting constitutes a public health risk. On March 16, 2020, the Texas Governor suspended certain requirements of the Open Meetings Act to permit open meetings to occur in a fully virtual setting (e.g., telephonic or videoconference meeting). In an effort to avoid and mitigate health risks, and limited occupancy levels, the Kerrville Recovery Community Coalition (KRCC) will convene in a virtual forum and attendance will be limited to only those persons essential to holding the meeting. No member of the public will be admitted during this time. **Despite the necessity to restrict public access to Kerrville Community Coalition meetings in the interest of public health during the COVID-19 pandemic, citizens and visitors are welcome to participate in KRCC meetings in several alternate ways as outlined below.**
