Kerrville-Schreiner Park Bow Hunt

Kerrville, Texas (November 6, 2013) – The wildlife management bow hunt will again be held at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, 2385 Bandera Highway, from November 29, 2013 to December 21, 2013. This is the seventh year for the event to be held. The Southside / Hillside area of Kerrville-Schreiner Park will be closed during this time to all traffic and park visitors. The Riverside of the park will remain open.

Hunters are selected in October by an electronic drawing process through the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department's *Public Hunt Program*. Information on the *Public Hunt Program* can be found at <http://www.tpwd.state.tx.us>.

In order to more fully utilize any available hunt positions, the program offers opportunities for standby hunters prior to each of the five hunt sessions. Under the standby hunter procedure, a prospective hunter needs to appear in person on the morning of the first day of a specific hunting session to have a chance to fill any available hunting position. In the event more standby applicants are present than standby positions are available, standby hunters will be selected by a drawing to be held at the park just prior to each hunt.
