### Official Candidates for the Kerrville City Council

**Kerrville, Texas (January 30, 2014)** – On January 30, 2014, Brenda Craig, City Secretary announced that the certification of five petitions had been completed and declared the following persons to be official candidates for the Kerrville City Council:

- Mayor: Jack Pratt and T. Scott Gross.
- Place Three: Sherri Jones and Gary Stork.
- Place Four: Eugene C. “Gene” Smith.

Candidate packets are available for persons who are interested in running on the May 10, 2014 ballot for Mayor, Place Three, or Place Four on the Kerrville City Council. In accordance with the City Charter, any person who lawfully qualifies, and is a registered voter of the city, may file a petition and application for election for a place on the City Council. A candidate petition and application can be picked up in the City Secretary’s office at City Hall, 701 Main Street, or by calling (830) 258-1117 Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The candidate’s name and the place for which he / she is filing must be affixed by the City Secretary at the time of issuance of the petition and application. To qualify to have a name placed on the ballot, the petition must be signed by not less than 75 registered voters

of the city and shall include a filing fee of \$25.00; however, the filing fee shall be waived where the petition includes the signatures of not less than 100 qualified and registered voters of the city. The last day to file is February 28, 2014.

Jack Pratt currently holds the position of Mayor; Justin MacDonald currently serves as Councilmember Place Three; and Gene Allen holds the position of Councilmember Place Four.
