### **End of Summer Special Events at Singing Wind Park**

**Kerrville, Texas (August 13, 2014)** – The Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department will be hosting two events this Saturday, August 16<sup>th</sup> at the Olympic Pool in Singing Wind Park. The first event, the 19<sup>th</sup> annual *“Kids Off-Road Triathlon”* will begin at 9:00 a.m. Hill Country Bicycle Works and the Parks and Recreation Department team up for this fun swim, bike, and run event. All children ages Pre-K to 18 years are welcome to participate. Athletes will be grouped according to their age and each group will swim, bike and run various age appropriate distances. A course map is available [online](#) on the Parks and Recreation webpage along with the distances for each age division.

Pre-register for this event at the Kerrville-Schreiner Park Headquarters located at 2385 Bandera Highway or [online](#) at [www.kerrvilletx.gov](http://www.kerrvilletx.gov) through August 15<sup>th</sup>. On-site registration will be available beginning at 7:30 a.m. at the Olympic Pool the morning of the event. The \$15 entrance fee includes a t-shirt, water bottle and door prizes. For families with multiple children participating, a discounted rate of \$10 for the second child and \$5 for each

additional child will apply. Bicycle helmets are required in order to compete in the bike portion of the event.

The second event on August 16<sup>th</sup> at the Olympic Pool is the ***“Wet N’ Wag Day”***, beginning at 4:30 p.m. and running until 7:00 p.m. Bring your swimsuit and favorite four-legged friend to play in the refreshing Olympic Pool. Don’t have a dog? You’ll have the opportunity to visit with representatives from the Kerr County Animal Shelter on how you can take home a new best friend. You will also be able to receive information on spay and neutering, grooming, and dog obedience training. The following sponsors will be available to answer questions from 4:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.: Hill Country Animal League, Nicole Scissorhounds, Obediently Yours, Pets Supplies Plus, Dogologie, and Veterans Assistance Dogs of Texas.

Activities planned for the evening include a doggie swimsuit contest at 4:30 p.m.; photo booth, off leash play area, and hike the trails from 4:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.; and fun in the Wading Pool and Olympic Pool from 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Current proof of rabies vaccination is required upon registration (tags or paperwork accepted). Owners are asked not to bring aggressive dogs and to please clean up after their pets. This is a free event but still requires registration.
