### **City Announces Appointment of David Knight as Chief of Police**

Knight has been serving as the assistant chief of police for the Kerrville Police Department for the past two years and most recently as the interim chief of police. During his nearly 20 year law enforcement career with the City of Kerrville, he has served as the field operations captain, detective – criminal investigations unit, traffic sergeant, patrol sergeant, patrol corporal and patrol officer.

“Our community is very fortunate to have an individual of David Knight’s caliber accept this appointment. Chief Knight has served the citizens of Kerrville since 1995 and has long been a shining star of the department. His promotion to this position is a result of his outstanding commitment to the community and to the field of public safety. Knight attended the University of Texas at San Antonio and is a graduate of the U.S. Army Infantry Officers Basic and Advanced courses. Knight holds a Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Master Police Officer Certification and is a member of the Texas Police Chiefs Association, the FBI National Academy Alumni Association, and the International Association of Chiefs of Police.
