### End of Summer Parks and Recreation Events

Kerrville, Texas (August 4, 2015) – The Kerrville Parks and Recreation Department will be hosting four end-of-summer events in August. The first event, “**Movies in the Park**”, is the final FREE movie to be shown this summer at the Kerrville-Schreiner Park Amphitheater. Bring the family out to watch “*The Lego Movie*”, sponsored by The Bosworth Company, on Friday, August 14<sup>th</sup> beginning at 9:00 p.m. Load up the car and bring the kids, blankets, and a flashlight for a free evening outside at the movies. Complimentary freshly popped popcorn will be served and a limited concession stand will operate during the movie. Please remember that glass containers are not permitted in the park. Entry to the park and movie is FREE.

The second event will be the following morning, Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup>. The 20<sup>th</sup> annual “**Kids Off-Road Triathlon**”, sponsored by Hill Country Bike Works will begin at 9:00 a.m. at Singing Wind Park. All children ages Pre-K-18 are welcome to participate. Athletes will be grouped according to their age and each group will swim, bike, and run various age-appropriate distances. The course map and age division distances are available online on the

Pre-registration for this event will be held at the Parks and Recreation Department located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, 2385 Bandera Highway or online at [www.kerrvilletx.gov](http://www.kerrvilletx.gov). On-site registration will be available beginning at 7:30 a.m. on August 15<sup>th</sup>. The \$15 entrance fee includes a t-shirt, water bottle, and the opportunity to win a number of great door prizes.

The third event, “**Wet N’ Wag**”, will be held on the same Saturday, August, 15<sup>th</sup>, at Singing Wind Park from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Bring your swimsuit and favorite friendly four-legged pal to play for FREE in the refreshing Olympic Pool. Current proof of rabies vaccination is required upon registration. “This event is held after the pool closes for the season,” said Ashlea Boyle, Special Projects Manager. “This is a fun way to spend some quality time with your dog. You could make a day of it by enjoying the new Dog Park and then the Wet N’ Wag event. Fido will have a great time swimming and meeting other pups.” There will be doggie treats and free giveaways at this event.
