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Kerrville 2050 Open Houses Set for April 19, 20 at City Hall

Kerrville, Texas (April 12, 2018) - The next opportunity for public input on the draft Kerrville 2050 Comprehensive Plan will be at two open houses scheduled for Thursday, April 19, from 4-6 p.m. and Friday, April 20, from 3-5 p.m. at City Hall.

The draft Future Land Use Plan and Thoroughfare Plan recommendations will be on display for review and comment. These drafts have been developed over the course of nearly eight months and are based on input received at the community retreat in November, community open houses in February, online and in-person surveys, and diligent work by seven subcommittees and the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee.

The subcommittees have met three times to develop evaluation criteria for the plan, create a first draft of Guiding Principles, and provide input on the potential implementation actions. Their work was completed in March.

The Steering Committee, which has been meeting since September, finalized the Kerrville 2050 Vision Statement and has had detailed input and provided direction throughout the process for the Future Land Use Plan and the Thoroughfare Plan recommendations. The

committee will meet again on May 7 to look at draft plan components and on May 30 to finalize their recommendation.

The final opportunity for community input will be at the public hearings leading to adoption of the Kerrville 2050 Comprehensive Plan, which are set for June 7 at the Planning and Zoning Commission and June 12 at the City Council. Final adoption is scheduled for June 26. More information is available on the project website at www.kerrville2050.com.

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
