Early Voting by Personal Appearance in the City Election begins Monday, April 23, 2018

Kerrville, Texas (April 18, 2018) – The City of Kerrville will hold an election on Saturday, May 5 for citizens to elect a mayor and two councilmembers. Only registered voters in the City of Kerrville will be allowed to vote in the May 5 City of Kerrville General Election.

Early voting by personal appearance will be held at the Kathleen C. Cailloux City Center of the Performing Arts, 910 Main Street:

- Monday and Tuesday, April 23 and 24, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Wednesday thru Friday, April 25, 26 and 27, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Monday and Tuesday, April 30, and May 1, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Voting on Election Day, Saturday, May 5, will be held at the Kathleen C. Cailloux City Center of the Performing Arts, 910 Main Street, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Election results will be available on the city's website www.kerrvilletx.gov after the polls have closed and ballots have been counted.
