Final Public Hearings and Adoption of Kerrville 2050 Comprehensive Plan Set

Kerrville, Texas (June 1, 2018) – Public hearings on the Kerrville 2050 Comprehensive Plan are set for Thursday, June 7 at 4:30 p.m. before the Planning and Zoning Commission, and Tuesday, June 12 at 6 p.m. before the City Council. Both hearings are at City Hall.

Final adoption is set for Tuesday, June 26 at 6 p.m. at the Cailloux Center.

At the public hearings, there will be a presentation on the final recommendation and an opportunity for public comment. Development of Kerrville 2050 began in September 2017 and has involved hundreds of citizens and stakeholders from throughout the community and the surrounding area. This level of interest and participation is unprecedented in the experience of the consultant team, Kimley-Horn, which has been involved in comprehensive plans all over the state for more than 25 years.
