Fall Adult Soccer League now taking registrations

Kerrville, Texas (Sept. 4, 2018) – Back for a fall installment is the *Kerrville Adult Soccer League*, which will begin Nov. 5, 2018. The team entry fee is \$300 and is due by Oct. 25. Games will be played at Singing Wind Park. A minimum of six teams are needed to begin a league. The season will run Nov. 5 – Dec. 10, two games per week for at least 12 guaranteed games. Format will be 8v8 play with the top six teams advancing to the playoffs at the end of the season. Get your teams together and get registered while there is still time!

The league is designed for 18 years and older, but 16 and 17 years of age can play with a parent waiver. Rosters will be capped at 13 players and the league is co-ed, but there are no regulations on the gender spread.

New to this season, a player-card policy will be implemented. Players will only be eligible to play in the league if they provide the Parks and Recreation Department photos of

themselves. Players will then be issued player ID cards that they will present to referees and officials prior to each game.

Referees are also highly desired. Referees in City leagues are paid \$20 per game with as many as six games per week. No license is required, but it is highly preferred.

Soccer packets including the by-laws and waivers are available for pickup at the Parks and Recreation Department, located at Kerrville-Schreiner Park, 2385 Bandera Hwy., or online at www.kerrvilletx.gov.

A mandatory captain's meeting will be held on Thursday, Oct. 25 at the Kerrville-Schreiner Park Administration Building located at 2385 Bandera Hwy. Teams must have representation at the meeting, with a maximum of two reps per team. Those that are interested in playing but do not have a team can contact the Parks and Recreation Department to be considered for pick up by one of the established teams; *however, this is not a guarantee.*
