City Returning to Year Round Water Conservation Stage

Kerrville, Texas (Sept. 21, 2018) – The last two months have seen more than 10 inches of rain fall on Kerrville and surrounding areas. The Guadalupe River flow has stabilized at over 100 cubic-feet per second, and our aquifer levels are on the rise. Water consumption has shown a corresponding drop to levels where overall consumption is less than 65 percent of the city’s safe operating capacity (SOC).

Because of these factors, the City of Kerrville is returning to Year Round Water Conservation measures effective 12:01 a.m. today, Friday, Sept. 21, 2018.

Year Round Water Conservation measures allow for landscape and lawn watering with hose-end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems daily from 6 p.m. to 10 a.m., and anytime for hand-held-hoses with nozzle, drip irrigation or buckets.
