City of Kerrville Receives Transparency Stars Recognition From Texas Comptroller

Kerrville, Texas (April 29, 2019) - Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced Monday that the City of Kerrville is the latest local government to achieve specific debt transparency goals through the Comptroller's Transparency Stars program. The City of Kerrville received a Transparency Star in the area of debt obligations, which recognizes entities whose websites show visual and narrative detail on outstanding debt, tax-supported debt obligations, historical bond elections and more.

Transparency Stars recognizes local governments that provide easy online access to important financial data.

"By providing taxpayers with essential debt information in a variety of formats, the City of Kerrville has shown a true commitment to Texas taxpayers. This effort achieves the goals set by our Transparency Stars program," Hegar said. "I am pleased to award the City of Kerrville a star for its accomplishments."

The Comptroller's office launched the Transparency Stars program in March 2016 to create consistent reporting requirements and recognize cities, counties, school districts and special purpose districts that go above and beyond in their transparency efforts.

The City of Kerrville received a Transparency Star for its reporting on traditional finance measures in September 2017.
