Charter Review Commission to hold public hearing

Kerrville, Texas (May 29, 2019) - The Charter Review Commission (CRC) for the City of Kerrville, Texas will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 4, 2019, beginning at 4 p.m. at Kerrville City Hall, 701 Main St. Prior to opening the public hearing, the CRC will make a presentation as to its proposed charter amendments. Following this presentation, the CRC will invite attendees to comment on its proposed amendments.

In November 2018, the Kerrville City Council established the Charter Review Commission composed of seven members. The City Council charged the CRC with reviewing the current City Charter and recommending any amendments. The CRC, beginning on Feb. 19, 2019, began meeting every other Tuesday and has held seven meetings since its inception.

Any member of the public may give the CRC, in writing or in person, any suggestions that are deemed desirable or needed for possible amendments to the City Charter. The

current City Charter may be reviewed online at the city's website; or, if you prefer, the CRC will provide anyone with a copy of this document. Besides appearing before the CRC at a meeting, comments may be emailed to the CRC at stuart.cunyus@kerrilletx.gov.

It is the CRC's hope and desire that any citizen of Kerrville with comments or questions regarding the City Charter will take the time to communicate these in some way to the CRC.
