### Bulk waste curbside collection set for October

**Kerrville, Texas (Sept. 29, 2020)** – The Public Works Solid Waste Division would like to remind citizens that Republic Services will be collecting bulky items Oct. 5-8 for residents that have trash pickup on **MONDAY**. For those who have trash pickup on **TUESDAY**, the bulky item collection will be Oct. 12-15. For trash pickup days of either **WEDNESDAY** or **THURSDAY**, the collection for bulky items will be Oct. 19-22.



This collection is for residents that have an active account for solid waste services with the City of Kerrville. It is recommended that you place items out on the weekend before your collection week, or at the latest by 7:30 a.m. that Monday morning. The trucks will only pass through a street once. It is the responsibility of the owner/tenant to remove any items that are not collected. Be aware that owners/tenants who have items out more than 10 days are subject to Code Enforcement and may receive a

violation notice. Also, scavenging of any items without the consent of the property owner is prohibited.

**Guidelines:**

- Items must be out no later than 7:30 a.m. on the Monday of your collection week.
- Do not place items on top of a water meter.
- Place items clear of power lines, branches, mail boxes, vehicles, and gas/water lines .
- Items with Freon must be tagged by a licensed technician showing that the Freon has been reclaimed.
- Carpet must be rolled and tied into sections not greater than 6 foot x 6 foot.
- This collection is for bulky items such as appliances, furniture, and other large items that do not fit in your trash bin. It is not intended for extra household trash, yard waste, or items that will fit in your trash or recycle bins.

**Prohibited Items:**

- Tires
- New or used oil
- Ammunition
- Fencing, or any type of construction debris (sheetrock, roofing, pallets, etc.)
- Household paints, chemicals, and other hazardous items
- Glass, mirrors, porcelain, or other brittle items
- Batteries

“These collections and the free vouchers we offer twice a year are great opportunities to discard unwanted bulky items,” Assistant Director of Public Works David Barrera said.
