

The Butt-Holdsworth Memorial Library is excited to share an increase in periodical availability through Overdrive. This will increase electronic periodicals from 50 to 3,200 and periodicals check out for 14 days.


To access OverDrive, when viewing the library catalog, at <http://libraryweb.kerrvilletx.gov>, scroll to the left middle of the screen and under Electronic Resources, select the OverDrive - Lone Star Digital Library hyperlink. This will allow access to periodicals, eBooks, audiobooks, and movies.

tive story about young love, a big secret in a small community, and ambition.


For wit and humor, the OverDrive book, *Hey Mom*, by Louie Anderson is available.

On the day she gives birth, a new mother must flee a catastrophic flood and find refuge in a world thrown into chaos. "A lyrical vision of the strangeness and beauty of new motherhood, and a tale of endurance in the face of ungovernable change."

Creatures by Crissy Van Meter

On the eve of Evangeline's wedding on Winter Island, the groom may be lost at sea, a dead whale is trapped in the harbor, and Evie's mostly absent mother has shown up out of the blue. From there, the narrative flows back and forth through time as Evie reckons with her complicated upbringing off the coast of Southern California.

Pizza Girl by Jean Kyoung Frazier

A coming-of-age story of a pregnant pizza delivery girl who becomes obsessed with one of her customers. Bold, tender, propulsive, and unexpected in countless ways, a moving and funny portrait of a flawed, unforgettable young woman as she tries to find her place in the world.

Tech Corner: TexShare Databases - Credo Complete Core Collection

BHML offers exclusive e-resources through the TexShare Databases. It allows access to over 27,000 journals, over 171,000 eBooks, and over 15 million images, videos, and interactive resources.

One such database is Credo, an easy-to-use tool for research, homework, and other reference needs. Gather background information on your topic from over one thousand full-text encyclopedias, subject handbooks, and current events resources, as well as 500,000+ images and audio files and over 1,000 videos.

The center of the page breaks down into three popular topics including humanities, health & medicine, and environmental science.

Humanities covers diverse areas like drone aircrafts, workplace violence, minimum wage, corporate responsibility, political activism, gun



control, human rights, unemployment, and censorship.

Health & medicine covers nutrition, clinical trials, hormone therapy, pregnancy, cancer, and pneumonia.

Environmental Sciences includes meteorology, climate change, national parks, carbon footprint, pollination, wildfires, and recycling.

Credo's Research Quick Tips allows users to learn and develop lifelong skills to find, evaluate and use information effectively. These short videos include topics such as Research Questions to Your Conclusion, How to Select a Topic, How to Find Relevant Sources, What To Do When Your Topic is too Broad, and Paraphrasing.

Not sure the content to search for in the search field? Use the drop down menu and select Topics. Topics connect users to real-time results from library-selected resources.
