TIPS FOR SENIORS

How to Screen Calls:

There are many people out in the world that will try to persuade you to buy, sell, invest and/or donate to causes that do not exist or are illegal. **NEVER** give out information over the phone, unless you know the person and trust them.

TELEMARKETING FRAUD

While telemarketers target people of all ages, backgrounds and incomes, they often make up to 80 percent of their calls to older consumers (according to the AARP). These telemarketers often prey upon older people who are well educated, have above-average incomes and are socially active in their community. Their sales pitches are sophisticated and include phony prizes, fraudulent sweepstakes, fake charities, and bogus investments.

STEPS TO TAKE:

- **Never send money** or give out personal information such as credit card numbers, bank account numbers, dates of birth, or Social Security numbers to unfamiliar companies or unknown persons.
- If you have doubts about a telemarketer's legitimacy, be sure to ask for their company's name and address, along with a phone number where they can be reached at a later time.
- For elderly widows, if a caller asks for the man of the house, be sure not to indicate that you live alone.
- Talk to family and friends, or call your lawyer, accountant, or banker to get their advice before you make any large purchase or investment over the phone with a stranger.
- Check out unfamiliar companies with your local consumer protection agency, Better Business Bureau, the National Fraud Information Center, or other watchdog groups. Be sure to sign up for the Federal Trade Commission's Do-Not-Call-Registry.
- Telemarketers who continue to call you after you have registered are subject to penalties. You can sign up at donotcall.gov or at (888) 382-1222. Don't forget the power to simply hang up the phone when a stranger calls trying to sell you something you don't want!

HOME IMPROVEMENT FRAUD

Home improvement contractors use several methods of targeting seniors: high pressure phone calls, flyers, advertisements, and door-to-door sales. Fraudulent contractors can be very effective in making people think their services are needed, and then defrauding their victims.

STEPS TO TAKE:

- Use a local well-established contractor. Ask for references and check them.
- Get competitive bids on all work and be wary of any bids that seem too good to be true.
- Don't accept high-pressure offers or offers that force you to make a quick decision.
- Determine exactly what work you want done. Make sure the project is explicitly described in your contract, including materials and labor specifics and dates for estimated start and completion.
- Never say yes to someone who wants money up front before job completion or wants you to withdraw a large amount of money from your bank.
- Check to see that the work is complete and done correctly before paying.
- Find out when and how payment and/or billing will take place before the work begins.

DOOR-TO-DOOR SALES

Seniors are frequent victims of door-to-door scams and high-pressure sales tactics. While some door-to-door salespeople are honest, the chances are likely that whoever answers the door is about to be swindled. Con artists often try to coax seniors into buying unnecessary products or services ranging from living trusts to encyclopedias to household cleaning supplies. They usually appear friendly and sincere in their desire to help. In fact, they are successful because they seem so honest. The City of Kerrville has an ordinance that prohibits solicitors from knocking on your door before 8:00 am and after 8:00 pm. If someone knocks on your door during this time, unless you are expecting someone, please do not open your door and report it to the City of Kerrville by calling 830-792-8000.

STEPS TO TAKE:

- Never allow anyone you don't know into your home. It is easier to close the door on them before they get in than to get them out once they are inside.
- Don't buy on impulse. Tell the salesperson you will get back in touch after you have had a chance to carefully read all the materials given to you.
- Ask to see the salesperson's credentials, identification, and request their business card.
- Never give cash up front to a salesperson or rely on verbal promises.
- If you sign a contract, make sure that it is complete, signed and dated. Get all terms in writing, including the total price, warranties, return policy, and all conditions of sale.
- Know that you can get out of a door-to-door sales contract within three business days. According to the FTC's Cooling Off Rule, you have the right to cancel your contract for a full refund until midnight of the third business day after the sale, provided that you have a signed contract and the sale was over \$25. You don't have to have any reason to cancel.

Travel Tips (Please note that with COVID-19 considerations, rules might change. Please contact your agent, hotels and airlines before traveling to be sure you have the most recent required information.)

When traveling by plane, train, bus or ship, around the world or just across state lines, learning useful tips and tricks will help you travel smoothly and be more relaxed. Here are just a few things to remember:

- When flying, always keep a small carry-on with you and have a change of clothes and your medication with you at all times. If luggage is delayed, this will ensure that you have what you need.
- Confirm any reservations, times and any other information with airlines, hotels, rental cars and other services. This will help prevent any problems.
- Be sure that you keep all your IDs and funds with you at all times. Do not leave any valuables in a hotel unless they are locked in a safe.
- Always be ready for delays and changes in schedules. Although you might have a set schedule, there can be issues that arise that are beyond your control. Patience can keep these changes from causing stress that can lead to health challenges.

Shopping

Most businesses offer rate discounts and other savings for seniors. Be sure to ask any of the businesses that you work with and shop at if a senior discount is available. Some simple questions are:

- Do you offer senior discounts and how much is the discount?
- Many consider different ages for seniors, so be sure to ask what the age requirement is for the discount.
- Is there a set day that you give a discount?

ASSISTED LIVING

Simply put, assisted living communities give older adults personalized care in a residential setting. They're for seniors whose health or well-being requires a higher level of support, which is determined through a health assessment by the community according to state regulations. Assisted living also provides a healthy lifestyle and social engagement.

The most common assisted living services offered include medication management and assistance with using the bathroom, dressing and grooming. Also typically included are housekeeping, meals, laundry and transportation services, as well as social programs and activities. Staff is available 24/7 to help with safety, care and support.

Assisted living is not the same as skilled nursing or nursing home care.

SKILLED NURSING/REHABILITATION CENTERS

A nursing home is a place for people who don't need to be in a hospital but can't be cared for at home. Most nursing homes have nursing aides and skilled nurses on hand 24 hours a day.

Some nursing homes are set up like a hospital. The staff provides medical care as well as physical, speech and occupational therapy. There might be a nurses' station on each floor. Other nursing homes try to be more like home. They try to have a neighborhood feel. Often,

they don't have a fixed day-to-day schedule, and kitchens might be open to residents. Staff members are encouraged to develop relationships with residents.

Some nursing homes have special care units for people with serious memory problems such as Alzheimer's disease. Some will let couples live together. Nursing homes are not only for older adults, but for anyone who requires 24-hour care.

Home Health

What's home health care?

Home health care is a wide range of health care services that can be given in your home for an illness or injury. Home health care is usually less expensive, more convenient than and just as effective as care you get in a hospital or skilled nursing facility (SNF). Examples of skilled home health services include:

- Wound care for pressure sores or a surgical wound
- Patient and caregiver education
- Intravenous or nutrition therapy
- Injections
- Monitoring serious illness and unstable health status

In general, the goal of home health care is to treat an illness or injury and helps you:

- Get better
- Regain your independence
- Become as self-sufficient as possible
- Maintain your current condition or level of function
- Slow decline

If you get your Medicare benefits through a Medicare health plan, check with your plan to find out how it provides for Medicare-covered home health benefits.

If you have a Medicare Supplement Insurance (Medigap) policy or other health insurance coverage, tell your doctor or other health care provider so your bills get paid correctly.

If your doctor or referring health care provider decides you need home health care, they should give you a list of agencies that serve your area. They must tell you whether their organization has a financial interest in any agency listed.

Hospice care

Hospice is considered the model for quality, compassionate care for people facing a life-limiting illness. Hospice provides expert medical care, pain management, and emotional and spiritual support expressly tailored to the patient's needs and wishes.

To qualify a patient for hospice care, a physician must certify a life expectancy of 6 months or less. Hospice care focuses on caring, not curing. The hospice team members bring care to the patient, caregivers and family in their private residence, nursing home, or assisted living.

Hospice is a Medicare benefit that covers:

- All items and services needed for pain relief and symptom management
- Medications related to hospice diagnosis
- Interdisciplinary team includes physicians, nurses, certified nursing assistances, social workers, spiritual counselors/chaplains, volunteers, and bereavement counselors
- Durable medical equipment for pain relief and symptom management

Palliative Care

Palliative care is specialized medical care that focuses on providing patients relief from pain and other symptoms of a serious illness, no matter the diagnosis or stage of disease. Palliative care teams aim to improve the quality of life for both patients and their families. This form of care is offered alongside curative or other treatments you may be receiving.

Palliative care is provided by a team of doctors, nurses and other specially trained people. They work with you, your family, and your other doctors to provide an extra layer of support that complements your ongoing care.

Palliative care is an approach to care that you may want to access at any stage of a serious illness. It helps you manage symptoms and address concerns that matter most to you. You may consider palliative care when you have questions about:

- What to expect with your care plan and how to tailor it to what matters most to you
- What programs and resources are available to support you throughout your illness
- Your treatment options and their pros and cons
- Making decisions in line with your personal values and goals
