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### **Schedule change announced for summer brush/yard waste pick up**

**Kerrville, Texas (June 3, 2022)** – Texas summer months bring unique challenges to Republic Services drivers and collection crews. Kerrville temperatures can become extreme, the town’s pedestrian and vehicular traffic becomes more active, and yards produce greater amounts of brush and yard waste. As a result, Republic Services is implementing a Summer Safety Plan aimed at reducing heat-related hazards to protect both staff and citizens.



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To keep drivers from being exposed to the hottest temperatures of the day, brush and yard waste pick up will begin at 6:30 a.m. each day rather than 7:30 a.m. This modified schedule will begin Monday, June 6 and continue through Friday, Sept. 23.

During these hot months, brush and yard waste should be placed curbside by 6:30 a.m. on Monday of your collection week and at least three feet away from other objects. This schedule change does not affect other solid waste services.

“Some of our divisions within Public Works also initiated a change in scheduling due to the extreme heat and dangers it can present,” Assistant Director of Public Works David Barrera said. “Brush collection typically requires a driver and one or two helpers to manually load piles or bags onto the collection vehicles. Given the size of the routes, we understand Republic Service’s initiative and request to modify the schedule.”
