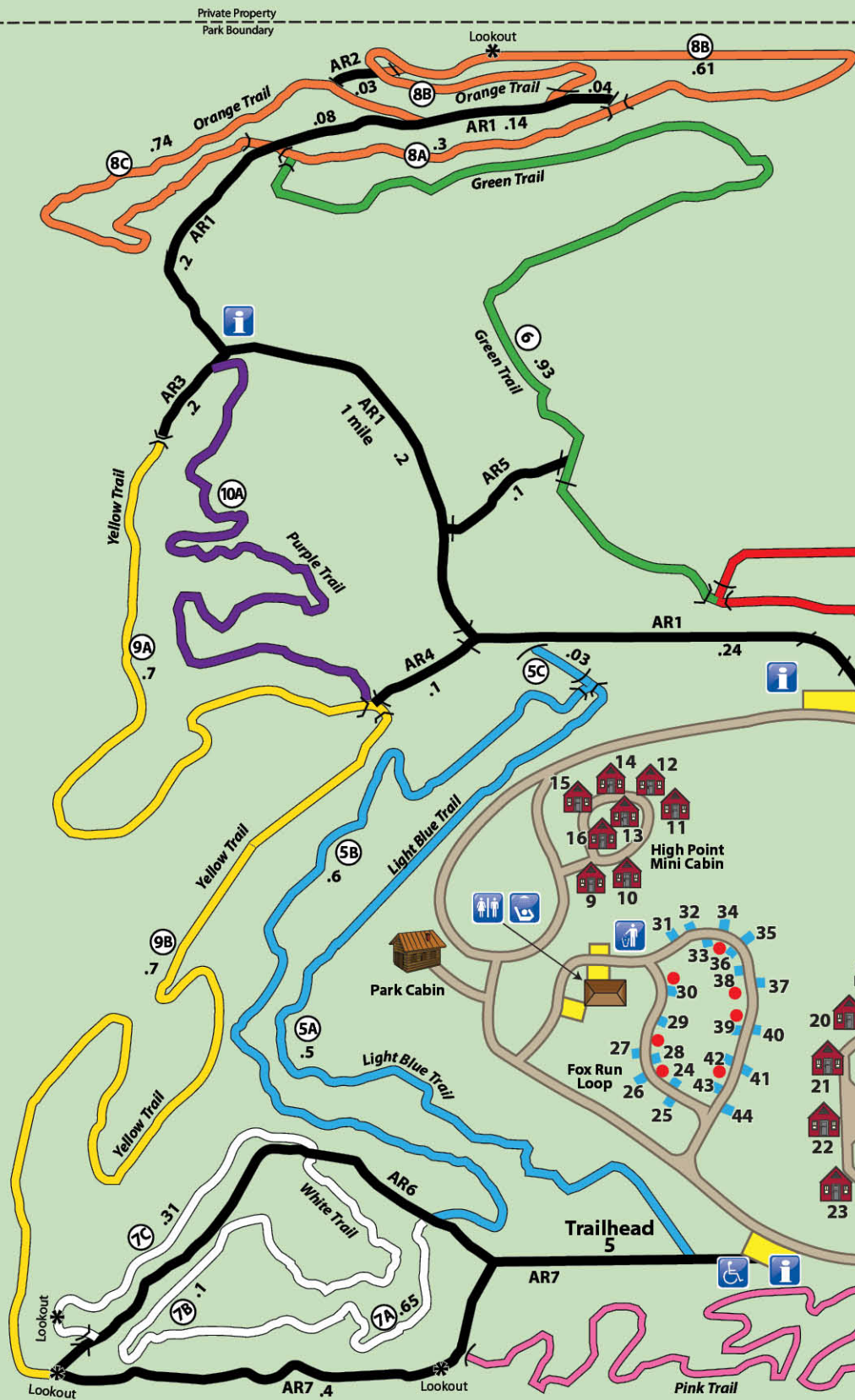

This is a multi-use, multi-directional trail system. Please be aware of and courteous to all trail users. Please wear a helmet when bicycling in the park. All dogs must be on a leash.

TRAIL LEGEND

- Trail ① – Teal – 2.03 miles
- Trail ② – Dark Blue – 0.63 miles
- Trail ③ – Pink – 1.66 miles
- Trail ④ – Red – 1 mile
- Trail ⑤ – Light Blue – 1.13 miles
- Trail ⑥ – Green – 0.93 miles
- Trail ⑦ – White – 1.06 miles
- Trail ⑧ – Orange – 1.7 miles
- Trail ⑨ – Yellow – 1.4 miles
- Trail ⑩ – Purple – 0.7 miles

The River Trail is an approximate 6-mile hike/bike concrete trail that extends from Kerrville-Schreiner Park to the Dietert Center.

Rules & Regulations

- No parking in grassy areas.
- Pursuant to City Ordinance, smoking is prohibited in all city parks including Kerrville-Schreiner Park.
- Pets are prohibited in any building in Kerrville-Schreiner Park including cabins.
- It is illegal for pets to be tied up outside or left tethered or unattended.
- All sites must stay clean and be free of debris.
- All numbered sites are for overnight camping only.
- No picking, pulling, tearing, digging up, out, or destroying any tree, shrub, plant, or vine.
- No feeding or providing food to any wildlife or feral animal.
- Check-out is at 12:00 noon; for an extended stay, you must get approval from the Park Office BEFORE 10:00 am.
- Quiet time is 10:00 pm to 6:00 am.
