City welcomes new library van for outreach purposes

Kerrville, Texas (Nov. 4, 2022) – The City of Kerrville recently purchased a new library van that will be utilized in an outreach capacity to deliver books to homebound residents, support programming outside of the library, and provide information about the library and city services. The van is wi-fi enabled and is outfitted with a generator, 42-inch TV, awnings, fold-out counter, shelving, lift-gate and book carts. Library staff will participate in community events and host pop-up libraries around town.

Friends of the Library supported the purchase of the library van with a donation of \$60,000. City council approved the purchase of the van on Jan. 26, 2021. Total cost of the van was \$95,330.
