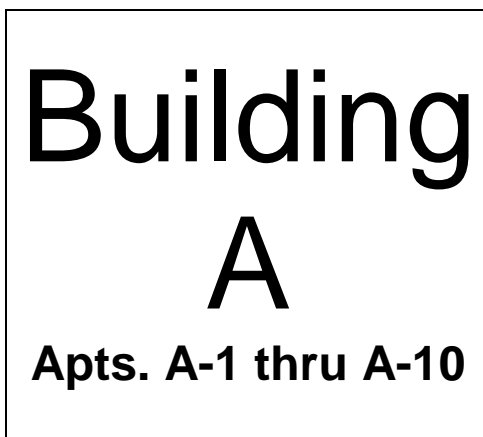
Section 9

Multi-Family and Commercial Multi-Building Complex Addressing

General Requirements

1. The permanent primary street address numbers¹ for a multi-family or a commercial multi-building complex shall be Arial font style numerals not less than 4 inches in height with a minimum stroke of ½ inch. The color of the address numbers shall contrast with their background and be located on the street-addressed (front) side of the property where they are prominently displayed and readily visible from the public right-of-way.
2. Each individual building in a multi-family or a commercial multi-building complex shall have its own identification designation¹ sign. Building identification signs shall be installed on the exterior of the building in at a location prominently visible from the fire apparatus access road. Lettering shall be Arial font style numerals and/or alphabet letters. The color of the numerals and/or letterings shall contrast with their background.
3. Building identification sign characters (alpha or numerical) shall be at least 12 inches in height with a minimum 1 inch stroke. For apartment buildings, the address range of the individual apartment units within the building shall be shown at the bottom of the building identification sign in 4 inch height characters having a minimum ½ inch stroke.

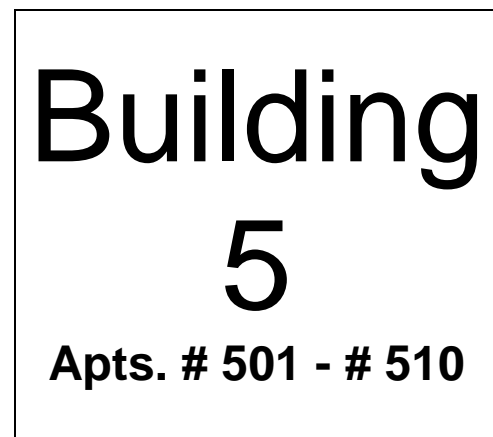

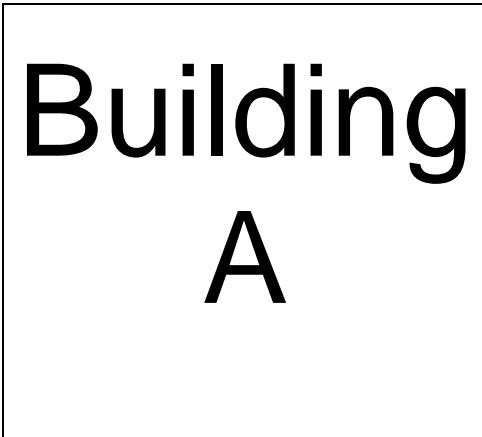

4. Individual apartment unit identification¹ shall be minimum 4 inches in height with a minimum stroke of ½ inch characters. The color of the characters shall contrast with their background.
