

The Kerrville City Council will consider the following items in a public hearing on February 11, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of Kerrville City Hall, 701 Main Street, Kerrville, Texas:

An ordinance to annex into the City of Kerrville's incorporated limits with a zoning classification of R-2 Medium Density Residential, 263.28 acres of land, more or less, out of original patent surveys in Kerr County, Texas, and being 116.24 acres out of Wm. Watt Survey No. 66, Abstract 365, and 147.04 acres out of David Schauchard Survey No. 67, Abstract 299, comprising all of a certain 250.31 acre tract conveyed from Rosemary H. Meek Romero to Rosemary Hunt Meek Ranch, LP by a Warranty Deed executed the 16th day of March 2017 and recorded in File No. 17-02161 of the Official Public Records of Kerr County, Texas, and 13.25 acres out of a certain 263.38 acre tract conveyed from the estate of Carl Donald Meek to Rosemary H. Meek by a General Warranty Deed executed the 19th day of October, 2000 and recorded in volume 1091 at Page 72 of the Real Property Records of Kerr County, Texas; generally located southeast of Kerrville-Schreiner Park and northwest of Comanche Trace and accessed by Bandera Hwy, Kerr County, Texas (KCAD Property ID 16315, 16316, 16317, 16323 and 17441).
