



“Christmas in Kerrville” Poem Search Rules and Regulations

Qualifying poem(s) must:

- Be titled “Christmas in Kerrville”
- Be tastefully written
- Be positive in nature
- Be descriptive of Kerrville
- Contain the word Kerrville in the body

Submission of poem(s) must:

- Include name, address, phone number, and email address of poet
- Include the City of Kerrville General Release form
- Meet qualifications
- Meet deadlines

Poems submitted that do not meet all qualifications will result in disqualification. Poems submitted will not be returned. Poems submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

Christmas in Kerrville feels just right.*

Key Dates

- Submissions will be accepted beginning Tues., Nov., 18, 2025
- Entries will close Tues., Dec. 2, 2025, 5:00 p.m. CT. Wednesday
- City of Kerrville chooses top 3 poems and posts to Facebook page
- Community and public vote on favorite submission from Dec. 3, 1 p.m. to Dec. 5, 10 a.m.

Official judges – City of Kerrville + YOU:

- Members of the City of Kerrville’s administration will review the poems anonymously and choose the top three.
- Citizens will then have the opportunity to choose one of the three by voting for their favorite on Facebook.

In Recognition of the winning submission, the winning poem / poet will receive:

- An Official City Proclamation from Mayor Joe Herring Jr. at the City Council meeting held on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at 6:00 pm, declaring poem as the Official 2025 “Christmas in Kerrville” poem
- Opportunity to read poem at the City Council meeting held on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at 6:00 pm
- Publication on the City of Kerrville’s Facebook page
- Publication in the Hill Country Community Journal on Wednesday, December 10, 2025
- Publication of the in the Kerrville Daily Times on Thursday, December 11, 2025
